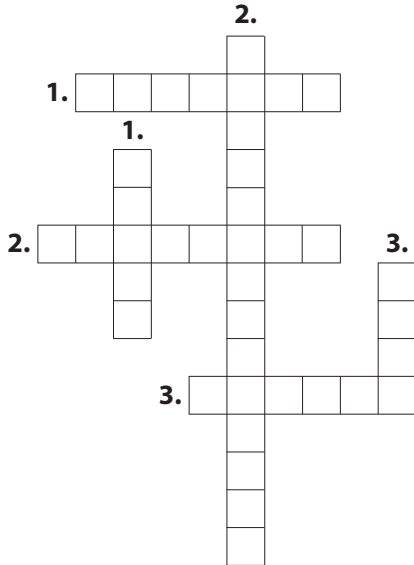

3. Principles or ideas that guide the behaviour of people and human society.

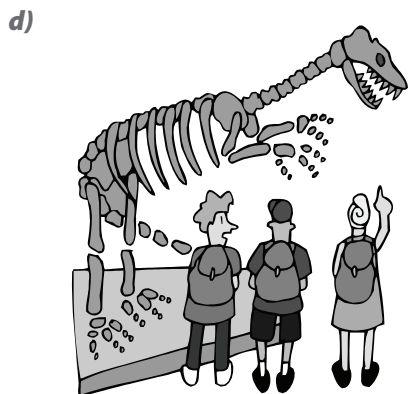

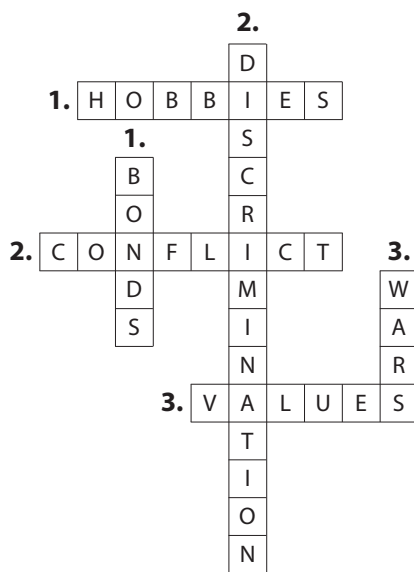
